Nursery and Primary One - APPLICATIONS 2017/18

Application forms for places in P1 and Nursery Unit closed at noon on 11th January. Parents will be informed in due course of their placement. There has been an unprecedented number of applications this year for Nursery.

Stage One of *Nursery* applications (for 3 year olds, essentially) ends on **26 April**, so parents of those children who have been accepted will be notified then. Other 3 year olds who are unplaced will have to wait until **8 June**, as will 2 year olds who may have applied.

Primary 1 parents will be sent out notification on **26 April** also.
